Jonathan Reso, Export Finance & Insurance Corporation (EFIC) – EFIC provides finance and insurance solutions to help Australian exporters overcome the financial barriers they face when growing their business overseas including borrowing to finance production

Andrew Steer, Grant Thornton – understand how to tackle tax issues around exporting, including exploring the option of establishing an office overseas
